"NOTIFICATION"

In order to implement the mandate of the National Action Plan on Climate Change and National Missions in the State of Himachal, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to create a State Centre for Climate Change in the State Council for Science Technology & Environment to study the impact of climate change on the Himalayan Eco-System and combat its effects through implementation of mountain specific adaptation plans. The centre has been created with the following objectives:

- To coordinate with different Universities, Research institutions, Government departments, NGOs etc to pursue theme based specific research on climate change in the Himalayan region and also to evolve and implement mitigation and adaptation plans.
- To act as a repository of climate change related information in the state of Himachal Pradesh.
- To generate awareness amongst various stakeholders for undertaking appropriate measures in combating the impact of climate change etc.

The administrative and financial functions of the State Centre shall be regulated by the Executive Committee of the State Council for Science Technology & Environment. The State Centre for Climate Change shall be governed on various aspects by a "Governing Committee" under the Chairpersonship of Chief Secretary to the Government of Himachal Pradesh. 
